

IQAC meet - I

IQAC meeting was conducted by the coordinator Dr. Dhaneshwar Prasad, HOD Mathematics, in room number- 317, 2nd floor, on 18th September 2014 between 3.30pm to 5.30pm. The chairmen of IQAC and Principal, Dr. R. Sundram, along with all the members of IQAC (except the member from outside the college) were present in the meeting. Some important suggestions were given by some members of the committee:

1. How and when the meeting is to be conducted without much disturbing the classes, It was decided to conduct IQAC meeting with all the members Quarterly ie (i) during the beginning of the second week of November, (ii) the last week of March and (iii) July every year. It was also decided to conduct ICT meeting ie faculty development program in the second week of November.
2. Information and Communication Technology was the highlighting point of the meeting. How to improve our communication using the present technology available with us was the focus point. Our effective communication should be made maximum using visual teaching aids like using computers, internet, star board, TV etc. These facilities are provided by UGC to all the departments of the college.
3. The chairman of IQAC suggested to have another communication scheme among the staff members ie INTERCOM.
4. Some member suggested to get increased the speed of the internet browser from 1 MBps to 3 MBps provided by BSNL, Yanam in order to do browsing faster.
5. Some member even suggested to have ICT meeting for a week instead of three or five days.
6. It was further suggested that when we have good communication technology, we should do something more on placement side to attract our students.

IQAC meet - II

IQAC meeting was held on 23rd Sept. 2015 between 3.30pm to 5.30pm. The following suggestions were made:

1. A teacher must adopt to have his /her own session and lesson planning. One must have a positive approach as far as teaching is concerned.
2. Every teacher must have some 4-5 students with even below average for counselling them now and then. This system is to be adopted and it should be a continuous activity of every teacher.
3. A teacher should identify some interesting topics related to the current courses / subjects; and students must be encouraged to collect some information related to the topic, and prepare a synopsis at the end. The same should be presented before the teacher/ students.
4. Every teacher should attend some training program which is available outside in plenty, and he / she should learn teaching methodology and should present to the same before the other students / faculty members of the college after attending the training program.
5. A gender sensitizing means allow boys and girls to sit wherever they like. Boys and girls should be given equal opportunities for completing any task given by teachers.
6. Human value based classes should be taken by a teacher at least once in a week in order to teach students some moral values of human live.

7. Identity card must be made compulsory to the students of our college in order to stop the outsiders from entering our college premise.
8. Conducting seminar in the college must be a regular phenomenon.
9. Student supporting activities like sports, yoga, cleaning program must be encouraged. Adopting a village by our NSS volunteers and teaching them what is right and what is wrong along with the importance of education in life is an example of student supporting tasks.
10. Improvement in teaching & learning, and improvement in lives of students should be made a continuous task for every teacher like a continuously increasing curve without stagnation.
11. Teaching about the environments and cleanness must be a regular feature in addition to the environment class.
12. Plan of Institution for the next academic year:
 - (i) Starting a PG course in chemistry in the next academic year.
 - (ii) Extension of the present building
 - (iii) Filling up of the vacancies of teachers
 - (iv) Renovation of the instrumentation lab
 - (v) National / International seminar to be conducted by some department.

STUDENTS ACTIVITIES/ ACHIEVEMENTS:

1. Two of our mathematics students got distinction in the main subject and one of them got 91.4%.
2. Mathematics Dept. Seminar was conducted regularly and it was done exclusively for the third years outgoing students to have some exposé of field other than their regular curriculum. One girl student, N. Chaitanaya, batch 2011-14, was felicitated with a text book and Rs. 1000/- cash because she topped in the class with 91.4%, and expected to get top rank in the University.
She is continuing one project “**INSPIRE**” under the IQAC coordinator, Dr. Dhaneshwar Prasad, funded by Dept. of Science and Technology, New Delhi.
3. One student, Miss. G. Sai Sangeetha, 2011-14 batch won **first prize** for the essay competition on Communal Harmony and National Integration conducted by Education Dept, Govt. of Pondicherry .
4. One student Miss. Jyothi Krishnaveni, Dept of Mathematics, 2013-16 batch was given **first prize** from Govt. of Puducherry for participating an essay competition on Perunthalai Kamaraj Birth centenary.
5. Mr Ramakrishna Durga Rao, Dept Zoology, batch 2012-15 , was also given **second prize** for the above said competition.
6. Two NCC camps were attended by our college students: (i) for senior cadets in the month of August 2014 and (ii) for juniors in the month of Sept. 2014. Lt. Dr Yoginder Singh, Dept. of Commerce, accompanied the junior cadets. Our college students got **top rank** in Volley ball tournament during the camp. Our NCC students participated in Khokho game competition during the camp.
7. Drinking water facility (like **Aqua Guard**) was provided to students at the second floor of the main block.
8. Each department of the college (including our college office) was provided with **inverter** facility in order to avoid the power crisis.

9. Under the UGC scheme, some computers with **i3, i5, i7processors**; Printer, Xerox machine were provided to each department.
10. Many **visual teaching aids** were also procured for each department like: LCD projector with its screen. Some departments also procured its movable stand . Some got TV, Smart board/ interactive board, Pen tablet, white board with stand.
11. Some **useful/ latest equipment** worth Rs. Seven Lakh were purchased by the Science department of the college in the academic year 2014-15.
12. Many books worth Rs. 45000/- for each dept. of the college were purchased in the year 2014-15 under UGC fund.
13. **Banners** for the college main block, Career & Counselling, IQAC were prepared and kept in the college at the proper places by the Principal Dr U. Pichaimani in the year 2014-15.
14. A well organized **conference hall** with audio visual facilities was made in the year 2014-15 in order to organize meeting/ seminar.
15. **Administrative block** was renovated by PWD, Yanam. The Principal Chamber was furnished with AC in the year 2014-15..
16. **Regular Examination** Under Pondicherry University was conducted successfully by our college staff in the month of May and June 2014.
17. **Distance Education examination** was also conducted by our college in the month of June 2014.
18. The college campus was **cleaned twice** in the year 2014-15.
19. **Clean India Week** celebrations from 26th Sept to 2nd Oct was declared by the Director of Education, Govt. of Puducherry, on 22nd Sept. 2014
